Physicians and staff in the Parkinson's and Movement Disorder Program at Froedtert & The Medical College of Wisconsin offers the most advanced, high quality, patient-centered care for people with the entire range of movement disorders, from the common to the rare.

- Team members include board-certified and fellowship-trained neurologists and a neurosurgeon who are movement disorder subspecialists, neuropsychologists, a geriatric neuropsychiatrist, a physiatrist, nurses, occupational therapists, physical therapists, rehabilitation psychologists, speech-language pathologists, a registered dietitian and a social worker.
- Comprehensive physical and neurological evaluation are completed with diagnostic imaging and neuropsychological testing.
- The latest treatment options are offered, including medication, complementary therapies like physical, occupational and speech therapy, wellness support, exercise, neuropsychiatry and neuropsychology, nutritional support, botulinum toxin injections, collagen injections and deep brain stimulation surgery.
- Patients have access to clinical trials. Medical College of Wisconsin physicians participate in national research studies to enhance the treatments for movement disorders.
- Education and support groups for families and caregivers dedicated to improving their quality of life.
- Co-managed care of patients with referring physicians to coordinate treatment and follow-up care.
