St. Joseph's Hospital Fact Sheet

St. Joseph's Hospital is an 70-bed acute care hospital serving residents of West Bend and surrounding communities and is a member of Froedtert & Community Health, a regional hospital system that includes Froedtert Hospital, Milwaukee; Community Memorial Hospital, Menomonee Falls; and West Bend Clinic.

The 180,000-square-foot hospital opened on August 7, 2005 on 143 acres on the northwest corner of Highway 45 and Pleasant Valley Road in the Town of Polk. The new hospital, which replaced an aging facility, continues St. Joseph's tradition of service to the community since 1930.

Facility Highlights

- 70 total inpatient beds:
 - 52 private medical/surgical rooms
 - Intensive Care Unit with six beds
 - New Life Center with 12 LDRP (labor, delivery, recovery, postpartum) beds, C-section suite, and two nurseries including a special care nursery
- Level III Emergency Care Center with nine private and four cardiac/trauma rooms
- Four large state-of-the-art operating rooms
- Full diagnostic services, including MRI, 64-slice CT scanner, nuclear medicine, ultrasound and general X-ray
- Adjacent medical building houses West Bend Clinic-South physician offices and the Cedar Crossings subacute care facility
- Breast Care Program, including the services of a breast care navigator
- Sleep Center in West Bend, including sleep studies and board certified Sleep Medicine Specialists from the West Bend Clinic
- The Kathy Hospice 8-bedroom residential hospice facility located on the hospital campus
- St. Joseph's Hospital has approximately 700 full- and part-time employees.
