
Froedtert & The Medical College of Wisconsin

Recognition

Froedtert & The Medical College of Wisconsin Froedtert Hospital named Top 100 Hospital

Truven Health Analytics, formerly the health care business of Thomson Reuters, recognized Froedtert & The Medical College of Wisconsin Froedtert Hospital as one of the nation's 100 Top Hospitals®. Froedtert also scored in the top 15 Major Teaching Hospitals in this 2013 analysis of Top Hospitals. The list compares peers in these categories: Major Teaching Hospitals, Teaching Hospitals and Large, Medium and Small Community Hospitals. Those hospitals listed are recognized by the study's authors as bringing higher value to their communities through better quality, higher efficiency and high perceptions of care.

Consumers Rank Froedtert Best

For the eighth straight year, Froedtert Hospital earned the National Research Corporation's Consumer Choice Award. This award identifies hospitals that consumers have chosen as having the highest quality and image in more than 300 markets throughout the United States.

Physicians Recognized as Best Doctors in America

Thousands of physicians across the country are surveyed each year to identify the most skilled specialists treating complex medical conditions. A total of 318 Medical College of Wisconsin physicians who practice at Froedtert were nominated by their peers as the Best Doctors in America®. The list includes more physicians from the Medical College than any other group practice or institution in Wisconsin.

National and Regional Top Workplace

Froedtert Health was named one of America's Top Workplaces by WorkplaceDynamics in 2012. Froedtert Health ranked No. 47 nationwide among 872 organizations with more than 1,000 employees who participated in regional top workplaces programs. Froedtert Health also ranked No. 8 in the top large employer category in *The Journal Sentinel's* 2013 Top Workplaces.

Healthiest Employer

Froedtert Health took second place in the large employer category for the *Business Journal's* Healthiest Employers awards. The Froedtert Health wellness program engages about 80 percent of staff who enroll in the medical plan. Staff who participate in the annual health risk appraisal receive a medical plan discount of \$360. Since 2009, the program and strategic wellness initiatives have saved the system more than \$3 million in health care costs.

Froedtert Health Awarded Gold Well Workplace Award

The Wellness Council of America awarded Froedtert Health's Wellness Works Program the Gold Well Workplace Award. The award recognizes organizations whose wellness programs meet the criteria outlined in WELCOA's seven benchmarks to a results-oriented Well Workplace.
