About Us

Froedtert West Bend Hospital is a full-service hospital serving residents of West Bend, Washington County and the surrounding area.

Froedtert West Bend Hospital provides 24-hour emergency care at its Level III Trauma Center, which is staffed by board-certified emergency medicine physicians. The hospital also offers a birthing center, inpatient and outpatient surgery, diagnostic services, and a sleep center. Comprehensive cancer care is provided at the hospital's Kraemer Cancer Center, a member of the Froedtert & the Medical College of Wisconsin Cancer Network. The hospital is a Certified Advanced Stroke Center by The Joint Commission, as well as a Certified Chest Pain Center from the American College of Cardiology Accreditation Services.

Froedtert West Bend Hospital is part of the Froedtert & MCW health network, a partnership between Froedtert Health and the Medical College of Wisconsin, supporting a shared mission of patient care, innovation, medical research and education. Our health network includes five hospital campuses, nearly 2,000 physicians and more than 40 health centers and clinics. We operate eastern Wisconsin's only academic medical center and adult Level I Trauma Center at Froedtert Hospital, Milwaukee. It is an internationally recognized training and research center engaged in thousands of clinical trials and studies. For more information, visit froedtert.com.

The hospital, established in 1930 as St. Joseph's Hospital, opened its current building in 2005, located between West Bend and Jackson, Wis., on Hwy 45 and Pleasant Valley Road.



Around Campus

At the Pleasant Valley Health Center, Medical College of Wisconsin physicians provide services in pediatrics, maternal fetal medicine, obstetrics & gynecology, allergy, cardiology, dermatology, electrophysiology, general surgery, infectious diseases, neurosurgery, physical medicine and rehabilitation, pulmonary care, urogynecology, urology, vascular surgery, and plastic and reconstructive surgery, including cosmetic surgery.

Froedtert West Bend Hospital Foundation was established in 2002 and supports current and future initiatives of the hospital and the Kraemer Cancer Center. The Foundation is dedicated to providing financial support for projects, programs and services of the organization. The generosity and vision of our donors helps ensure excellence in patient care and services. Without their support, providing these initiatives close to home would not be possible.

The 17,000-square-foot West Bend Surgery Center includes three operating rooms along with two procedure suites for ear/nose/throat, gastrointestinal, general, gynecologic, orthopaedic, plastic, and podiatry procedures. The free-standing center is physically attached to the west side of Pleasant Valley Health Center on the hospital's campus, providing greater convenience to services to best compliment services in the West Bend region.

The Kathy Hospice is an eight-bedroom residential hospice facility on the Froedtert West Bend Hospital campus, operated by Horizon Home Care and Hospice. The hospice provides a peaceful and comfortable environment for those in need of end-of-life care. It is the first free-standing residential hospice in Washington County and provides respite care, short-term inpatient care, continuous residential care and home hospice care.

Partner volunteers of Froedtert West Bend Hospital provide service to hospital patients, staff and the community. Partner volunteers assist in the hospital's Well Wisher Gift Shop, raise funds to support hospital programs and award annual health-related scholarships to local high school students. The organization is a member of Partners of Wisconsin Hospital Association.
