## \*Guidelines for visiting a patient in isolation:

- Limit of two visitors at the same time. Follow other designated visitor guidelines above.
- Visitors should go directly to the patient's room and remain in the room during the visit, except to use the public restroom.
- For everyone's safety, visitors must wear personal protective equipment (PPE) and follow all instructions provided.

## **General guidelines:**

- Visitors must pass a health screening.
- Visitors under 18 years of age must be supervised at all times by an adult. For patients in the emergency department or hospital, the adult cannot be the patient.

## **Exceptions may include:**

• Patients with disabilities or who are minors; end-of-life decisions and care; other limited situations.
